2019 Community of Christ Conference Report

Volunteers came from as far away as Arizona and California to join LifeLine members and friends hand out tracts and chat with attendees at the 2019 Community of Christ (COC) World Conference. Approximately 300 new tracts created for the conference and 300 to 400 other tracts were distributed.

Our volunteers generally were well received. Despite a few antagonistic responses, they demonstrated daily that the ministry's

efforts were being done out of love for the COC people and not for any other reason.

Three new tracts written especially for COC members, clearly and concisely contrast Biblical Christianity with COC doctrines. Open Forum Announced



Other changes made include the expansion of In the years that followed, many changes took the doctrinal charts in Chapter 3 to reflect the beliefs of the RLDS Restoration Branches along with the current beliefs of the COC, the LDS Church and Biblical Christianity. Additional testimonies have also been added to Chapter 16.
